13. MUSEUM OF OLIVE OIL Established 1864

The museum exhibits all traditional tools for transport, production & storage to present the whole process of making olive oil on the island Brač, as well as artworks showing oilery workers by academic artists Hana-Marta Jurčević Bulić and Đani Martinić. Visitors can taste & buy awarded olive oil made by Cukrov family.

14. ISLAND BRAČ MUSEUM, ŠKRIP

The museum is situated in Škrip, the oldest settlement on the island. Within the building enclosing the Illyrian walls, the Roman mausoleum and the Croatian tower, there is a rich archaeological collection. Ethnographic artefacts represent the agricultural, sheep-breeding and stone-craft tradition of Brač.

16. DOMINICAN MONASTERY Bol

The monastery was build in 15th century. The greatest attention in the valuable monastery's gallery are Tintoretto's altar painting Madonna with Child and Saints & ceiling painted by Croatian baroque painter Tripo Kokolja. In the Monastery you can find museum that contains valuable collections, as well as interesting garden.



17. BLACA HERMITAGE

Hermitage of Blaca is unique monument on the Croatian coast, added on UNESCO World Heritage Tentative List. It was established by two Glagolitic priests running away from the Turks in 1551, and was in use also as a farm, school & private astronomical observatory for over 400 years. Today, hermitage of Blaca is also a rich museum.



18. SENJKOVIĆ WINE CELLAR

Senjković wine cellar will overwhelm you with perfect blend of tradition & youth, warmth & enthusiasm of this hardworking family who dedicated their time and love to produce "the drop from heaven". Tasting wines from vineyard consisted from 75,000 grape vines, and their exceptional food offer is highly recommended experience.

RANDOM FACTS ABOUT BRAČ

1 Many famous buildings were built of Brač stone - Diocletian's Palace, Austrian Parliament, Hungarian Parliament, Reichstag in Berlin... They say even the White house!

2 Brač is the tallest island in the Adriatic. On a clear day, you can see Italy while standing on the top of Vidova Gora (778 meters above sea level).

3 Did you know Zlatni rat is world's 3rd most beautiful beach (European Best Destinations)? Wind moves it up to 50m left-right & changes its color.

4 Once upon a time, Brač was a rare island with its own river, and still has a bridge called Franz Joseph Bridge. Today it is mostly used by free climbers.

5 Dragon Cave is a must-visit, mysterious location near village of Murvica. It was a temple and dwelling of the glagolitic priests. Visit is possible only with the guide.

6 Brač has more than 10 different dialects! If you are familiar with the Croatian language, when on Brač, this might not be as useful as you think.
