#1 Zadar was elected Best European Destination 2016! When in Zadar, don't forget to listen to the sound of the Sea organ, a unique facility in Europe.

Sunset in Zadar is the most beautiful in the world, according to famous Alfred Hitchcock who tried to catch it with his camera from former Hotel Zagreb, room 204.

The main street in Zadar is named Široka ulica (široka = wide) and it is believed it's as old, or even older, than the city itself.

Forget NBA, it's here where you'll find true fan(at)ics of the game. In fact, so much that their motto is 'God may have created a man, but Zadar created basketball!'

Zadar's sphinx was built in memory of a beloved woman. Some say it grants love wishes. Spinxes are very rare in this part of Europe; this one is the biggest.

11. ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM ZADAR
Archaeological Museum Zadar was established in November 1832 as part of the general museum of natural goods, industrial products and antiquities. It became an autonomous institution in 1880. The museums permanent exhibitions include prehistoric, Roman antiquity and medieval collections.



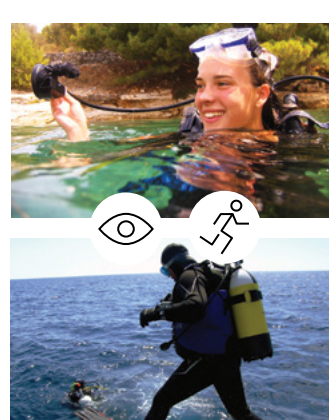
12. BACKSTAGE BAR

14. CHURCH OF ST DONATUS — C. 9TH
The church of St Donatus in Zadar is located in the centre of the historical core of the city, on the ruins of what used to be an ancient forum. It was dedicated to the Holy Trinity, but it was renamed in the 15th century and today carries the name of St Donatus, the bishop who, legend has it, commissioned its construction probably in early 9th century.



15. DIVING ZLATNA LUKA
They are situated in the middle of the Adriatic coast, the most indented part, including the group of islands in the channel of Sit, the island Zut & the two pearls of the Adriatic, the National park — Kornati and the Park of Nature — Telašćica. They offer: diving every day, diving excursions, diving courses, Kornati diving & Padi center.



16. FAUST VRANČIĆ MEMORIAL CENTRE
At Faust Vrančić Memorial Center you will be introduced to the life and work of Faust Vrančić, a man who is mostly remembered today as an inventor of Homo volans-the flying man. However, he was much more than that. Take a look at the collection of his inventions containing life size models and his most significant written works of art.



17. LEDANA LOUNGE BAR
This modern designed bar offers a unique atmosphere of the lounge bar, integrated into the ambience of the historic park. The tradition of concerts, presenting various events and entertainment L&B Ledana (Icehouse) continues on its own stylish and unique way.

22. SPECIAL HISTORIC DINNER
The tumultuous past of Ravni Kotari, with its interlacing of venerable eastern and western influences, from the Republic of Venice to the Ottoman and Austro-Hungarian Empires, each left its mark on the local gastronomy and created wonderful local recipes and fantastic flavours.



23. THE MUSEUM OF NIN ANTIQUITIES
The most valuable findings which are kept in the Museum of Nin Antiquities are two original old Croatian boats from the 11th century called Condura Croatica. Next to them there is a copy of part of the boat called Serilia Liburnica from the 1st century and a replica of the Baptismal font of Duke Višeslav.



24. RESTAURANT GIARDIN
On a daily basis, you can enjoy delicious fish dishes prepared by the traditional recipes, high quality steak, all kinds of appetizers, salads, pasta and of course one of the best pizza in town. Large spacious terrace suitable for family with children.



25. SEA ORGAN
This architectural object located on the western end of Zadar's Riva plays music through sea waves and tubes located underneath a set of large marble steps. Croatian architect Nikola Bašić received the European Prize for Urban Public Space in Barcelona for this project. It is included in the top 10 Croatian landmarks by Trip advisor.



26. THE GREETING TO THE SUN
It consists 300 multi-layered glass plates placed on the same level with the stone-paved waterfront in the shape of a 22-meter diameter circle. Under the plates there are photo-voltage solar modules through which symbolic communication with nature is made, with the aim to communicate with light, like Sea Organ do with sound.



27. FIVE WELLS SQUARE
The square is between the City Walls and the Renaissance bastion Grimani, where the oldest park in Croatia is located, named after Queen Jelena Mađjevska. In the 16th century, the Venetians helped the city of Zadar survive Turkish sieges by building a large water cistern with five ornamental wellheads, giving the square its name.



28. FORUM
The forum is the name given to all ancient Roman Empire's main city squares which used to be centers of public life. The one in Zadar, located in front of the church of Saint Donat and the Archbishop's Palace, represents a very developed example of the forum complex, and is one of the most important among the Adriatic ancient cities.



29. THE MUSEUM OF NIN ANTIQUITIES
