

The City Theater of the Youth from Split was founded in December 1943 in Croatian refugees camp in El Shat as The children's cultural-artistic society named Tito's Sailors, whose members were children refugees transported to Africa across the island of Vis and Italy. So, this is probably the only European theater that was not founded in Europe.





The Klis fortress, one of the most significant fortifications in Croatia, due to its strategi importance had a significant defense position. The most turbulent time of the history of Klis was the beginning of the 16th century, the time of the greatest Turkish invasion to these areas. Town duke and his warriors Uskoks managed to resist Turkish attacks and besieges for two and a half decades. Over the years, the fortress was the most important and powerful Croatian fortification in Dalmatia.



3 TROGIR



Trogir is situated in the middle of Dalmatia, on the Adriatic coast. Due to its position and natural protection, it is one of the most popular sea-ports and destinations for nautical tourists. Numerous attractions such as Dubrovnik, Šibenik, Zadar and national parks are within the radius of only a couple hundred kilometers. Since Trogir is not far from the airport, only 5 kilometers; to the exit for the high-road only 15 kilometers, no matter where you come from, not one port, not one island is that far from Trogir to make this town unavoidable. Add to this the number sunny days and you have an ideal destination for adventures exploring of Dalmatia, a lazy vacation, escape from land and wondering through the aquarium of the Adriatic



5 KASTELA



The town of Kaštela is located on the coast of the Bay of Kaštela. Our town is specific because of the fact that it developed around 7 settlements (Kaštel Štafilić, Kaštel Novi, Kaštel Stari, Kaštel Lukšić. Kaštel Kambelovac, Kaštel Gomilica and Kaštel Sućurac) or around castles. The beauty of Kaštela and the Field of Kaštela inspired many poets who described their beauty in many poems."Seven villages like seven swans" became a motto of the town of Kaštela. In the most parts of the Field of Kaštela vinevards, olive groves, cherries, figs and autochthonous Mediterranear vegetation trade places with monuments of natural heritage and park architecture.

manuel Vidović Gallery is dedicated to the person and art of Emanuel Vidović (Split, 1870-1953), one of the most eminent Croatian artists. The name of Emanuel Vidović is a synonym for superior art and one that has deeply marked one of the artistic poles of the 20th century Croatian art. Gallery is the place where the artist's material and spiritual legacy is gathered, studied, protected and presented. It is a part of Split City Museum and it is situated in the classicist house at the Silver Gate of Diocletian Palace.

The Centre for Culture and Lifelong Learning Zlatna vrata has always been a place of lively cultural and education activity, ranging from lifelong learning, exhibitions, public discussions, stage performances and concerts to the screenings of art-house and non-commercial films. The Centre is housed in a medieval Palace of Diocletian at the heart of the historical core of Split and has one of the most beautiful cinemas in Croatia, regarded by the locals nd guests as a hub of cultural activity for the whole city.

MARITIME MUSEUM

Croatian maritime museum Split is situated in 17th century fortress Gripe close to downtown. Its two exhibitions, merchant and military one, tell a story of importance Adriatic sea had through Croatia's exciting history. In the courtyard there is open-air part, including bow of teamship, traditional Croatian boats and naval weapons.

The Meštrović Gallery houses masterpieces made by famous Croatian sculptor Ivan Meštrović (1883 – 1962), covering all the periods of his rich creative work. The Gallery was built according Meštrović's own design (1931 - 1939), and was intended to be his family home and exhibition space. It is surrounded by a Mediterranean garden which, with its bronze sculptures and the view of the sea and of the Central Dalmatian islands, makes a unique example of landscape architecture.

MEET SPLIT - THE CAESARS CITY




Split lies on the Adriatic coast, central Dalmatia, on the Split (Marjan) peninsula. Although surrounded by sea as a peninsula, Split also borders with surrounding mountains, Mosor on the northeast, Kozjak on the northwest, and Marjan hill as one of the most important symbols of the city, rising on the west side of the peninsula, in the immediate vicinity of the old city centre. Split is also surrounded by the islands Brač, Hvar, Šolta and Čiovo. Split is the largest city in Dalmatia, second largest city in Croatia and according to the latest census conducted in 2011 Split has almost 180 thousand inhabitants. Second largest Croatian cargo harbour, but also one of the largest passenger harbours on the Mediterranean. It is the administrative centre of the Split & Dalmatia County



The story of Split is already 17 centuries old, dating to the time the Roman Emperor Diocletian decided to build his Palace right on the peninsula near the great Roman city Salona, where he wanted to spend the last years of his life. During these 1700 years the Palace slowly turned into a city, which to this day lures with its rich tradition, glorious history and beauty of its natural and cultural heritage.


Diocletian Palace and the entire historical core of Split have been on the World Heritage UNESCO list ever since 1979, and not only for the extraordinary preservation of the Palace, but also because the Palace and its city (or the city and its Palace, if you like) continue to live a full life.

Tumultuous history leaves its trace in the everyday life of the city that always moved steadily forward, remaining the centre of this part of the coast to this day. In those mixtures of history layers, clumsiness was inevitable, sometimes even rashness in development, but today it is all a part of its originality.


